Duty of Candour Virtual Drop-In Clinics for Primary Care Providers May to December 2024

Dear Colleagues

Firstly, on behalf of the Once for Wales Concerns Management System (OfWCMS) Programme Team, I would like to thank you all for your continued support and commitment in reaching our Primary Care provider colleagues across NHS Wales.

You will recall that the OfWCMS Programme Team held Duty of Candour Primary Care Reporting virtual drop-in clinics during 2023 and the first half of 2024. The purpose of these sessions was to provide familiarisation to Primary Care providers in accessing and navigating the Datix Cymru system, to support Primary Care providers to support them to prepare for their duty to report under the Duty of Candour, which became a Legal requirement on 1st April 2023 as part of the Health and Social Care (Quality and Engagement) (Wales) Act 2020.

The feedback from the virtual drop-in clinics was extremely positive and there is an appetite for further virtual drop-in clinics to be set up.

The OfWCMS Programme Team are delighted to confirm that further virtual drop-in clinics have been set up for May to December 2024 and will again focus on providing familiarisations to Primary Care providers in accessing and navigating the Datix Cymru system.

The Once for Wales Concerns Management System (OfWCMS) Programme Team are committed to supporting the ongoing implementation of the Duty of Candour in Wales, which became a Legal requirement on 1st April 2023 as part of the Health and Social Care (Quality and Engagement) (Wales) Act 2020.

The OfWCMS Programme Team held virtual drop-in clinics to provide familiarisation to Primary Care providers in accessing and navigating the Datix Cymru system during the month of March 2023 and again during the months of October 2023 and November 2023. The feedback from the virtual drop-in clinics was extremely positive and there is an appetite for further virtual drop-in clinics to be set up.

The OfWCMS Programme Team are delighted to confirm that further virtual drop-in clinics have been set up for 2024 and will again focus on providing familiarisations to Primary Care providers in accessing and navigating the Datix Cymru system.

As a reminder, under the duty NHS bodies, including primary care providers, are required to capture and report on occasions where the Duty of Candour is triggered.

The platform for capturing and recording instances where Duty of Candour is triggered is Datix Cymru. This is a secure, cloud based, interactive system which enables Primary Care providers to make the necessary reports and, where accessing the system via a login, see updates on cases. The Datix Cymru system is also used to notify patient safety concerns to the relevant Health Board.

Datix Cymru is available to all primary care providers and is accessed via a dedicated website https://nwssp.nhs.wales/a-wp/pcir/
