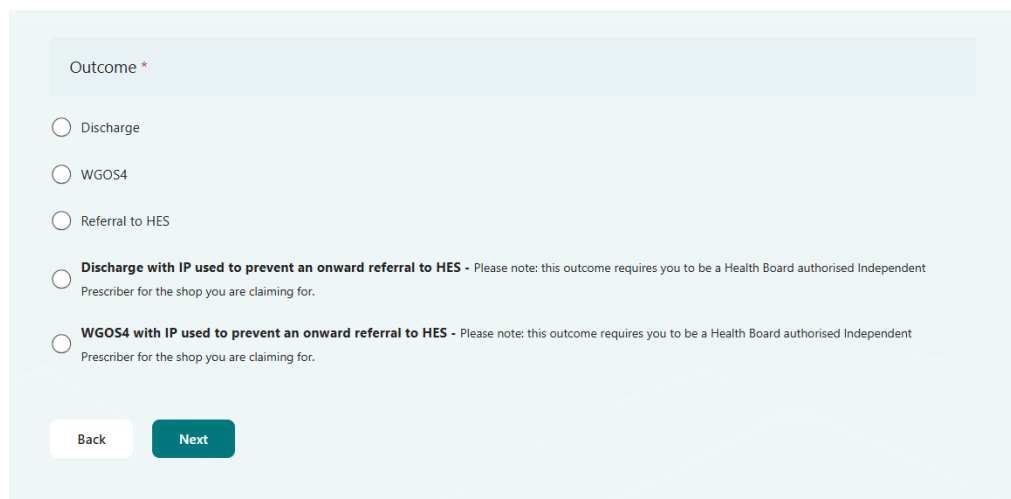
Dear WGOS4 provider,

As of today, the WGOS4 claim form has been amended to allow for the 2025 WGOS fee changes.

These allow the claiming of an IP supplement where;

1. IP was used in conjunction to WGOS4, and in doing so a referral to secondary care was prevented. To claim the supplement and
2. You are an approved IP for the Health Board and Practice in which you are making the claim.

The screen shot below highlights the change to the Microsoft form, and for ease of reference we attached the most recent WGOS fee changes.

PAYMENTS TO OPTOMETRISTS PROVIDING ENHANCED OPTOMETRY SERVICES

We have reached agreement with Optometry Wales on the payments eligible to optometrists providing the Wales General Ophthalmic Services (WGOS) Enhanced Optometry Services for 2025-26. The Cabinet Secretary for Health and Social Care has approved these recommendations which are set out below.

The new payment structure outlined in Table 1 becomes operational from 01 April 2025 and relates to the arrangements set out in The Eye Health Examination Service Committee (Wales) Directions 2016 and The Low Vision Service Committee (Wales) Directions 2016, as amended by the National Health Service (Wales Eye Care Services) (Wales) Directions 2023.

Ffioedd Gwasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol a Gwasanaethau Archwilio Llygaid / Ffioedd Ymweliadau Cartref y GIG

5. Mae Ffi (Prawf Golwg y GIG) Gwasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol wedi cynyddu ar gyfer 2025/26 ac mae wedi'i phennu ar £46.20, gan ddod yn weithredol o 1 Ebrill 2025 ymlaen.
6. Mae'r Ffi Gwasanaeth Archwilio Llygaid sy'n weithredol o 1 Ebrill 2025 ymlaen fel a ganlyn - mae GOCC 2 Band 1 yn £72.88; GOCC 2 Band 2 yn £55.18; a GOCC 2 Band 3 yn £27.07.

Taliadau Cydweithrediadau Optometreg Clwstwr o 1 Ebrill 2025 ymlaen

9. Er mwyn sicrhau cysondeb o ran ymgysylltu ledled Cymru, mae Cydweithrediadau Optometreg Clwstwr yn cael eu sefydlu gyda dyletswydd ar bob practis optometreg o fewn y clwstwr i ymgysylltu drwy gymryd rhan yng nghyfarfodydd y Cydweithrediadau Proffesiynol Optometreg. Rhaid i bob practis optometreg fynd i o leiaf 4 cyfarfod y flwyddyn ariannol, a dylid ei ad-dalu am fynd i bob cyfarfod, hyd at uchafswm o bedwar cyfarfod. Rhaid gwneud taliadau yn unol â'r Datganiad o Dâl am Wasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol a Chyfarwyddydau Ffioedd.

Uchafswm ffi fesul claf o fewn y Gwasanaeth Llygaid mewn Ysbyty

10. Bydd uchafswm ffioedd y Gwasanaeth Llygaid mewn Ysbyty yn parhau fel a ganlyn: £70.00 ar gyfer lensys golwg sengl; a £113.80 mewn unrhyw achos arall.

Taliadau ar gyfer Datblygiad Proffesiynol Parhaus (DPP)

11. Mae'r taliadau mewn cysylltiad â datblygiad proffesiynol parhaus yr ymgymeryd ag ef yn 2024 gan optometryddion, optegwyr cyflenwi ac ymarferwyr meddygol offthalmig heb benodiad meddygol arall (h.y. nad ydynt yn gwneud unrhyw waith arall am dâl oni bai am ddarparu Gwasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol) wedi'u nodi yn y Datganiad o Dâl am Wasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol a Chyfarwyddydau Ffioedd. Bydd canllawiau pellach yn dilyn maes o law gan Bartneriaeth Cydwasanaethau GIG Cymru (NWSSP).
12. Gwneir taliadau mewn cysylltiad â hawliadau a wneir gan optegwyr cyflenwi, optometryddion ac ymarferwyr meddygol offthalmig sy'n ymwneud â hyfforddiant DPP yr ymgymeryd ag ef yn ystod y flwyddyn rhwng 1 Ionawr a 31 Rhagfyr 2024. Rhaid

Grant goruchwylwyr cyn-gofrestru

13. Mae'r lwfans a delir i oruchwylwyr hyfforddeion cyn-gofrestru yn aros ar £7,500. Dylid talu hawliadau gan hyfforddwyr sy'n ymgymryd â'r gwaith o oruchwyllo hyfforddeion cyn-gofrestru ar 1 Ebrill 2025 neu ar ôl hynny ar y gyfradd hon.

Grant i Bractisau (Uwch Dystysgrif Broffesiynol mewn Glawcoma a Retina Meddygol GOCC 4)

14. Er mwyn annog contractwyr i ryddhau optometryddion i gwblhau'r gofynion clinigol ar gyfer Uwch Dystysgrif Broffesiynol y Coleg Optometryddion mewn Glawcoma a Retina Meddygol, caiff practisau optometreg eu had-dalu ar gyfer pob sesiwn glinigol y bydd optometrydd yn mynd iddi at ddibenion cyflawni'r cymhwyster, hyd at uchafswm o ddeugain sesiwn (20 diwrnod). Rhaid gwneud taliadau yn unol â'r Datganiad o Dâl am Wasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol a Chyfarwyddydau Ffioedd.

Ansawdd Optometreg

15. Er mwyn gwella trefniadau llywodraethu ymhellach, mae safonau Gwella Ansawdd ffurfiol wedi'u cyflwyno ar gyfer Optometreg yng Nghymru. Mae angen systemau gwella ansawdd cadarn er mwyn mesur a sicrhau canlyniadau o'r radd flaenaf i gleifion yng Nghymru. Fel rhan o'r cynllun, mae'n ofynnol i gontractwyr gwblhau offeryn System Adrodd Genedlaethol y Gweithlu Cymru (WNWRS) lle nodir gweithlu eu practis; llenwi'r templed llywodraethu Ansawdd Optometreg; cymryd rhan mewn, a chwblhau, tri archwiliad bob blwyddyn (archwiliadau clinigol ac anghlinigol); ac ymgymryd â hyfforddiant gorfodol yn ôl yr angen. Rhaid gwneud taliadau yn unol â'r Datganiad o Dâl am Wasanaethau Offthalmig Cyffredinol a Chyfarwyddydau Ffioedd.

GENERAL OPHTHALMIC SERVICES AND EYE EXAMINATION SERVICES FEES, DOMICILIARY FEES, PAYMENTS FOR CONTINUED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, PRE-REGISTRATION SUPERVISORS GRANT, PRACTICE GRANT FOR COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRISTS PROFESSIONAL HIGHER CERTIFICATE IN GLAUCOMA AND QUALITY FOR OPTOMETRY.

Summary

1. I am writing to notify you of the:
 - a) General Ophthalmic Services (NHS Sight Test) Fee, Eye Examination Services Fees and domiciliary fees from 1 April 2025;
 - b) Optometry Collaborative Cluster Payments from 1 April 2025;
 - c) Hospital Eye Service maximum patient charge from 1 April 2025;
 - d) Continued Professional Development payment for 2024 calendar year; and
 - e) Grant payable to supervisors of pre-registration trainees;
 - f) Practice Grant for College of Optometrists, Higher Professional Certificate in Glaucoma;
 - g) Quality for Optometry.
2. Please could you bring this information to the attention of all staff dealing with primary care ophthalmic services, i.e. dispensing opticians, optometrists, ophthalmic medical practitioners and other staff concerned with the hospital eye service.
3. Local Health Boards should ensure that copies of this letter are distributed to all dispensing opticians, optometrists and ophthalmic medical practitioners in their areas.
4. The determination and directions to Local Health Boards contained in the [Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions 2025](#) are made in the exercise of the Welsh Minister's powers in sections 12(3), 76, 77 and 203(9) and (10) of the National Health Service (Wales) Act 2006.

General Ophthalmic Services and Eye Examination Services Fees / NHS Domiciliary Fee

5. General Ophthalmic Services (NHS Sight Test) Fee has increased for 2025/26 and is set at £46.20, effective from 1 April 2025.

6. The Eye Examination Service Fee effective from 1 April 2025 is – for WGOS 2 Band 1 set at £72.88; WGOS 2 Band 2 set at £55.18; and WGOS 2 Band 3 set at £27.07.
7. For NHS domiciliary visits carried out on or after 1 April 2025, the fee is £42.60 for the first and second patients and £10.66 for third and subsequent patients.
8. Payments must be made in accordance with the Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions.

Optometry Collaborative Cluster Payments from 1 April 2025

9. To ensure consistency of engagement across Wales, Optometry Cluster Collaboratives are being established with a duty for each optometry practice within the cluster to engage through participating in the Optometry Professional Collaborative meetings. Each optometry practice must attend at least 4 meetings per financial year and is to be reimbursed for attending each meeting, up to a maximum of four meetings. Payments must be made in accordance with the Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions.

Maximum Patient Charge within the Hospital Eye Service

10. The Hospital Eye Service maximum charges will continue to be: £70.00 for single vision lenses; and £113.80 in any other case.

Payments for Continued Professional Development (CPD)

11. The payments in respect of continuing professional development undertaken in 2024 by optometrists, dispensing opticians and ophthalmic medical practitioners without another medical appointment (i.e. who do no other remunerative work but Primary Ophthalmic Services) are set out in the Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions. Further guidance will follow in due course from NHS Wales Shared Services Partnership (NWSSP).
12. Payments will be made in respect of claims made by dispensing opticians, optometrists and ophthalmic medical practitioners relating to CPD training undertaken during the year from 1 January to 31 December 2024. Payments must be made in accordance with the Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions.

Pre-registration supervisors grant

13. The allowance paid to supervisors of pre-registration trainees remains at £7,500. Claims from trainers taking on pre-registration trainees on or after 1 April 2025 should be paid at this rate.

Practice Grant (WGOS 4 Higher Professional Certificate in Glaucoma and Medical Retina)

14. To encourage contractors to release optometrists to complete the clinical requirements for the College of Optometrists Professional Higher Certificate in Glaucoma and Professional Higher Certificate in Medical Retina, optometry practices will be reimbursed for each clinical session an optometrist attends for the purposes of

attaining the qualification, up to a maximum of forty sessions (20 days). Payments must be made in accordance with the Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions.

Quality for Optometry

15. To further improve governance arrangements formal Quality Improvement standards have been introduced for Optometry in Wales. Robust quality improvement systems are necessary to measure and ensure the highest quality outcomes for patients in Wales. As part of the scheme contractors are required to complete a National Workforce Reporting tool outlining the workforce in their practice; make a return of the Quality for Optometry (QO) governance template; participate in and complete three audits (clinical and non-clinical) annually; and undertake mandatory training as required. Payments must be made in accordance with the Statement of General Ophthalmic Services Remuneration and Fee Directions.

17. If optometrists, dispensing opticians or ophthalmic medical practitioners have any queries then they should contact their Local Health Board or Primary Care Services at NWSSP.
